The Ice Plant Story

The Gabler family owned and ran the original Ice Plant. Their primary business during the early 1900's was producing ice, manufacturing ice cream and bottling soda pop. Hence, giving the business its name "The Ice Plant." The Gabler's would draw water from the river and freeze large blocks of ice to be sold. The ice was stored in dividers under the upper-level floor and packed in cork. The ice was sold locally and shipped by flat boat upriver to various businesses.

When their daughter, Selma married Bob Mavin, they converted the original building into their winter eatery and later made a dance hall in the upper level of the building. During the summer months, they ran The Custard Stand on Route 88 near Cabbage Flats.

Local teens enjoyed hanging out and dancing in the dance hall. Teens from surrounding communities also made their way to The Ice Plant and formed lifelong friendships and even found love.

Prior to the building burning in January 2014, the graffiti from the bygone days was visible in the horse-hair mortared walls. Those walls were preserved for decades and many stopped just to recapture a time in their lives. Can you imagine if those walls could talk?

Selma continued the food part of the business until 1979 when she retired.

OUR STORY CONTINUES

In 1981, the Rumble family bought the property from the Gabler family. They added an addition to the backside of the original building to have a game room for the local kids. Unfortunately, the 1985 Election Day Flood destroyed the interior. The Ice Plant remained vacant for 17 years.

Curt & Lisa Rumble Miller bought the property and soon began renovations to revive the Ice Plant of the past. The doors opened for the restaurant in June 1995. They transformed the upper level to a bar in 1999 with the original accents preserved.

March 2001, a fire struck due to a transformer failure. The original building survived; the addition was destroyed. After extensive renovations and a new floor plan, the restaurant reopened in August.

On January 5, 2014, a horrific fire struck once again. This time, totally the original beloved Ice Plant. The loss was devastating for Lisa and the lot remained vacant for four years. In 2018, the original pavilion was enclosed to begin rebuilding the restaurant. The doors on the walls of the dining room are originally from the Gabler homestead found on the property.

The outside patio area was where the original Ice Plant stood. Rick Krajnak built the wall and used block preserved from the fire to cap the wall. The block is in its original state at the time of the fire.


